RULES FOR RIDING THE BUS SAFELY

- Be at your assigned bus stop 5 minutes before the scheduled bus arrival time
- Ride only your assigned bus to and from school
- Remain off the highway/street while waiting at the bus stop
- Show respect for other's feelings and property
- Show respect for and obey the Bus Driver at all times
- Adhere to seat assignments given by the Bus Driver
- Do not stand or change seats when the bus is moving
- Ensure that the aisles remain open
- Keep noise to a minimum at all times
- Do not eat or drink on the bus
- Do not throw objects in or from the bus
- Refrain from placing any body parts out of the windows.
- Enter and exit the bus in an orderly manner
- Move away from the bus immediately when exiting
- Only cross the street in front of the bus

Routing Guidelines

- Bus stops: Stops are designated to reduce ride time. Bus stops are designated on public property using landmarks such as street corners, fire hydrants, etc.
- Routes: Our goal is to provide the safest and most efficient routes possible. Routes are designed using a computer routing program, which are then personally driven to look for hazards. Bus routes will not be designed requiring:
 - Three point turns
 - Buses entering into cul de sacs
 - Students to cross busy streets to get to bus stop (age appropriate)
 - Buses to enter parking lots to pick up students
- Walking distance: The Illinois School Code 105 ILCS 5/29-3, states that children are allowed to walk up to 1 ½ miles to school or a bus stop. We recommended that Parents accompany their children to the bus stop assigned.
