



Faith Formation:

St. Patrick School is a Catholic, child-centered, elementary school where the staff, parents and parish community educate the whole child spiritually and academically. We help children develop their personal relationship with God, particularly as they prepare to celebrate the Sacraments. We strongly encourage family participation in our Parish community and at weekly Mass.

General Information:

Each grade has two classrooms with up to 30 children per class. Each unit has two teacher aides. Children will be randomly placed in classrooms each year and have daily opportunities to interact with all children within their grade.

Bus Service:

Tuition Compliance Activities and Volunteer Opportunities

Virtus Training:

All parochial school volunteers and employees within the Archdiocese of Chicago are required to complete four requirements of VIRTUS training, prior to working or volunteering at school. This includes classroom parties and coming in to your child's classroom even for one hour, or coaching a sport. - ◆ Complete VIRTUS Training. A three-hour training session that all school volunteers and employees are required to attend. These sessions are also referred to as “Protecting God’s Children”, and are an informational meeting to create a level of awareness regarding child safety.
- ◆ Complete the online background check form via our website.
- ◆ Complete the Archdiocese Code of Conduct form via our website.
- ◆ Complete the CANTS (DCFS) form via our website. Note: This is an annual required form to be completed by all volunteers.

20 Hour Compliance Activities

Being a Catholic school means the funds for our school come directly from the tuition of the school families, parish support and any additional fundraising. Fundraisers are staffed through our required tuition compliance activities. All families are required to dedicate approximately 20 hours to one or more fundraising activity selected prior to the start of the school year.
