**JOG-A-THON COMPLETE DRESS DOWN DAY**

All students will receive a full dress down day on Thursday, October 11<sup>th</sup> for their participation in the Jog-a-thon fundraising event. Please remember to review the Parent Student Handbook for the full dress code. Parents will be called if clothing is not appropriate for school. Below is a summary of the regulations.

**Non-uniform Days:** Clothing on non-uniform days may include jeans, sweats, sleeved/crew necked t-shirts, athletic shoes and sandals with backs. During the appropriate seasons, only uniform shorts may be worn (**Shorts are no longer allowed as of Oct. 1.**) We encourage students to wear St. Patrick spirit wear. Pants should fit properly (not tight, oversized, or wide-legged). Shirts must extend below the waist and shirt material must be solid, not sheer. If girls choose to wear a skirt/dress to school, it must be no more than 1" above the knee. Messages on shirts should be positive and Christian. **Shorts, yoga pants, leggings, are not allowed.**  
SHOES: any TIE athletic shoe (tennis, basketball, sneaker). Do Not Wear: slip-ons, dress, open-toed, flip flops, Uggs, workbooks. Students must always wear socks.
