SCRIP NEWS: So we're finally going back to school! Since it has been a VERY LONG time since our children wore their uniforms, they've probably long since outgrown everything they had. If you're in need of new uniform items from Dennis, please contact Susan Grum in the office. Paper gift certificates are available through the Scrip program and can be applied to any new Dennis order - earning much needed money with every purchase. Even new school shoes to complete your child's uniform can be purchased through your favorite retailer using the ScripNow option on ShopwithScrip.com. eCards purchased through this program for hundreds of retailers can be used for online or in-person shopping within minutes of purchase. It couldn't be any easier to social distance! Although you may have put off ordering back-to-school supplies (pencils, and markers and notebooks...oh,my!) not knowing where things were headed for this school year, it's time to buy them now. If you didn't order a complete set of supplies through EPI, all items on the list can be purchased at local stores or online if you

prefer. Use Scrip to pay for your purchases at Target, Walmart or Amazon to get your kids set for the upcoming year. If you did order a back-to-school supply kit through EPI, the remaining items on the school supply list which aren't included in the kit (tissues, ziplock bags, wipes, paper towels, bandaids, etc.) can all be purchased with Scrip wherever you do your usual family shopping. Think of it like giving a double gift to the school - they get the classroom supplies they need and earn the money needed to help offset the cost of the special supplies needed during the pandemic. See you soon - at a safe distance, of course!
