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DEAR PARENTS,

The sounds of music are coming to your child's school! MUSIC ON THE MOVE, the nation's premiere music program, is now offering an outstanding opportunity for your child to learn to play the musical instrument of his or her choice and at the same time develop a lifelong skill. Music instruction will be provided by dedicated MUSIC ON THE MOVE professionals, who work closely with your child to provide the finest music education possible.

WHAT INSTRUCTION IS OFFERED?

Our experience shows that, IN GENERAL, the following instruments can be offered for the grades below:

Grade 3: RECORDER

Grade 4 & older: FLUTE, CLARINET, SAXOPHONE, TRUMPET, TROMBONE, PERCUSSION (these are the BAND INSTRUMENTS!)

Grade 5 & older: FRENCH HORN (also a BAND INSTRUMENT) plus all the instruments above.

WHERE DO THE INSTRUMENTS COME FROM?

Students must have an instrument by their second lesson. If you already own an instrument, please have it inspected by a local music dealer to ensure that it is in proper working order. (For 3rd Graders registering for the recorder, no instrument purchase or rental is required. The recorder will be provided to each recorder student at the first lesson at no additional fee.) If you do not yet have an instrument, we strongly recommend that you contact the PM MUSIC CENTER (please see their attached flier), a highly reputable, local music dealer whose "RENT-TO-OWN" plans begin as low as \$23 per month and include repair and maintenance services. Please give them a call (AS SOON AS YOU ENROLL!) at [630] 978-9927 so that they can help you make all the proper arrangements to obtain a good-quality instrument. Please mention that you are a student with MUSIC ON THE MOVE.

WHEN AND WHERE DO THE LESSONS TAKE PLACE?

Small group lessons, 30 minutes in duration, will take place in your child's school once a week during the school day. Classes are not held on any day that school is not in session. Lessons are scheduled during the entire year (32 lessons maximum, depending on your school's calendar.) Students discover tone production, the joys of rhythm and reading musical notation. Each student will in time participate in school recitals.

BAND-A-RAMA

This exciting event is a musical/pedagogical collaboration of all of our students and staff from our Lake County schools. Our students will have the opportunity to work with special "guest artists" and "guest conductors" and present a Festival Concert - ALL on one day! It's fun!

HOW CAN MY CHILD PARTICIPATE?

Your total investment for the year will be \$569.00. LATE STARTERS' tuition will be adjusted accordingly. TO PARTICIPATE, simply complete the form below and return it to your school (main office) within the next 4 (four) school days with the amount due of \$144.00. This amount includes an annual, non-refundable registration fee of \$25.00, which provides for all necessary method books, music and other materials for the school year, AND the first tuition installment. The remaining balance for the year's lessons will be billed subsequently and may be paid in one, two or three installments. You may use either VISA or MASTERCARD, or make checks payable to MUSIC ON THE MOVE. Lessons will begin in about two to three weeks!
